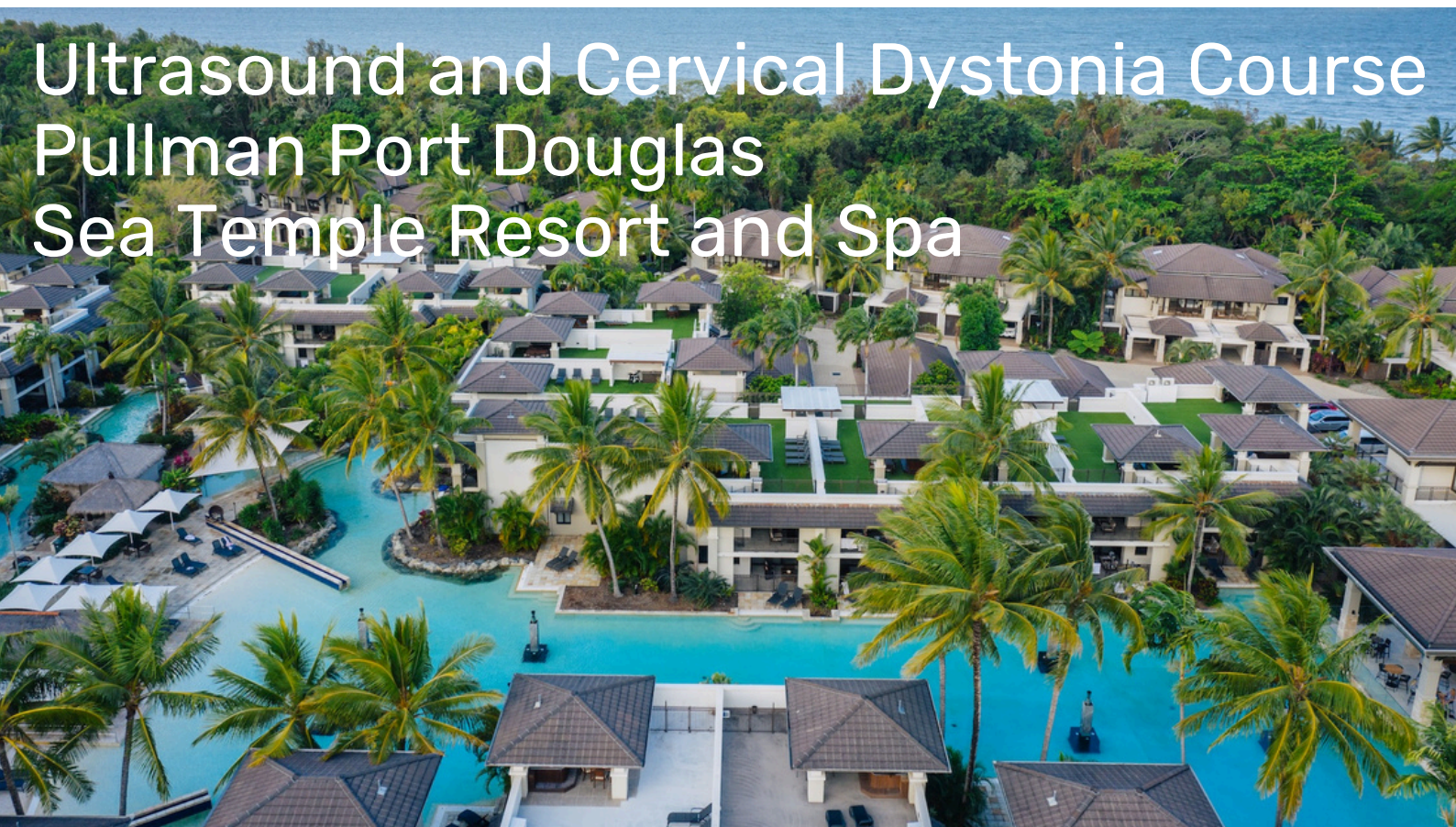

Registration is open to attend the NeuroRehabilitation Sunshine Coast Centre of Excellence Advanced Cervical Dystonia Convention, to be held at the Pullman Port Douglas Sea Temple Resort and Spa from 30th March to 1st April, 2026. The education event is a 3-day cervical dystonia ultrasound course which is exclusively open to accredited registrars and consultants in rehabilitation medicine and neurology. The course will focus on identifying muscles commonly affected in cervical dystonia with ultrasound. Salivary gland identification for treatment of sialorrhea will also be included. It is hoped that this workshop will assist you to develop the expertise and confidence required to offer treatment for these conditions in your clinical practice using ultrasound. No injections will be performed as part of this course.

It is expected that participants will already have a sound understanding of anatomy prior to attending the course. Teaching will be provided by Dr Warren Jennings-Bell, Dr Jom Jiao and Dr Juan Rois, who have developed expertise in performing ultrasound-guided botulinum toxin injections for spasticity and cervical dystonia.

The number of convention positions are limited and available on a first come first served basis.

Convention cost is \$1650 (including GST). Travel and accommodation expenses are not included in the registration fee. Morning tea and lunch is included for attendees on convention days only. Please dress comfortably and appropriately for the convention. Attendees will be required to practice ultrasound on each other.

Accommodation is available through www.pullmanportdouglas.com.au and a promo code will be provided following approval of your application. 1 to 3 bedroom villas are available on a first come first served basis. There are several other accommodation options in Port Douglas should you wish to stay elsewhere.

Flights are to be arranged by attendees. Major airlines fly to Cairns. Transfers to Port Douglas are to be arranged by attendees. The Pullman offers airport transfers which can be arranged during the accommodation booking process.

A convention cancellation fee of \$400 AUD applies to all cancellations up until 27/02/2026 after which date a 50% cancellation fee will apply. Cancellation fees for accommodation costs are at the Pullman Resort's discretion.
